

StonyCreek Spring Simulator Golf League 2026

• Schedule

- We will play every week 2/16-3/29
- If you have scheduling conflicts, let us know as you can play a round early. Also, if you cannot find a time with your partner during a week, you can play alone and simply reserve an hour to get your round in.
- There is no penalty for missing a week, however you cannot play a week late. Sunday is always the last day of play for the given week

• Fees

- Each team will pay a \$60 League fee. 100% of league fees will go into the league prize fund. Payouts will be in the form of a StonyCreek GC Gift Card distributed at the end of the season.
- Weekly fees: League rate for sim time is \$33/hr
- **NEW: Hole in One Pot!** Teams may pay \$12 additional for the Spring Session (\$1 per player, per round). If anyone gets a Hole in One in the 6 weeks, they will split the pot with all other Hole-in-Ones in the session. If there are no Hole-in-Ones, there will be drawing with all players entered, for the pot.

• Booking

- You can book via phone 317-773-1820 or online at <https://stonycreekgolfclub.com/golf-simulator/> and click Book Sim Time
- If booking online, utilize the drop-down menu for Simulator 1 and Simulator 2 to see all available times
- 2 hours should be enough time for your 2-person team to hit a couple warm up shots and play 18. Your 1st round or 2 may take longer, so feel free to book 2.5 hours if you need to

• Technology

- StonyCreek staff will be available to help as need be for round setup.
- No Mulligans are allowed in League Play. We will keep the Unlimited mulligan feature on as the computer may have a faulty shot here and there.
- The technology is fantastic, but it is a computer, sometimes it glitches. We'll be here to help.

• Play/Format:

- Week 1-6 the format will be 1 best ball net. This means each 2-person team will count their 1 best net score on each hole. Lowest total score is the winner. We will also have closest to the pin on each par 3
- Because of the format, a player may “pick up” on a hole if you are confident, your partner will make the better score
- Gimmies: We will set gimmies to 10 feet, meaning once you hit a shot inside 10 feet your next shot is automatically counted as in the hole.
- Only on your first shot per hole, are you allowed to use a tee.

Scorecards:

- We will have paper scorecards each week that have dots to indicate how many strokes each player gets given their hcp. We will use 50% of your handicap.
- Course and yardage for the week
- Course settings
- Par 3’s listed with space to record distance to the hole for the closest to the pin
- Scorecards will be available at the counter when you check-in and need to be turned in when you’re done
- Points will be awarded based on your team’s finish position each week and the top 2 point earning teams will play a championship match at the conclusion of the league. 3rd and 4th place will play a bronze medal match.
